NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the annual general meeting (“**Meeting**”) of Hong Kong Education (Int'l) Investments Limited (“**Company**”) will be held at Bauhinia Room, 3/F, Regal Riverside Hotel, 34–36 Tai Chung Kiu Road, Shatin, New Territories, Hong Kong on Tuesday, 19 December 2017 at 10:15 a.m. to consider and, if thought fit, pass the following resolutions, each an ordinary resolution:

ORDINARY RESOLUTIONS

1. To receive, consider and adopt the audited consolidated financial statements and the report of the directors (“**Directors**”) and the auditors (“**Auditors**”) of the Company for the year ended 30 June 2017.
2. To re-elect Mr. Tsang Ka Wai as an executive Director.
3. To re-elect Mr. Yip Chung Yin Jeffrey as an executive Director.
4. To re-elect Mr. Wong King Hoi as an executive Director.
5. To re-elect Mr. Fong Chak Kiu as an independent non-executive Director.
6. To re-elect Ms. Jor Stephanie Wing Yee as an independent non-executive Director.
7. To authorise the board of directors of the Company (“**Board**”) to fix the remuneration of the Directors.
8. To re-appoint HLB Hodgson Impey Cheng Limited as the Auditors and to authorise the Board to fix its remuneration.

9. **“THAT:**

- (a) subject to paragraph (c) below, the exercise by the Directors during the Relevant Period (as defined below) of all the powers of the Company to allot, issue and deal with the unissued shares in the capital of the Company (“**Shares**”) and to make or grant offers, agreements and options (including warrants, bonds, notes and other securities which carry right to subscribe for or are convertible into Shares) which might require the exercise of such powers, be and is hereby generally and unconditionally approved;
- (b) the approval in paragraph (a) above shall authorise the Directors during the Relevant Period to make or grant offers, agreements and options (including warrants, bonds, notes and other securities which carry right to subscribe for or are convertible into Shares) which would or might require the exercise of such powers after the end of the Relevant Period;
- (c) the aggregate number of Shares allotted, issued or dealt with or agreed conditionally or unconditionally to be allotted and issued or dealt with (whether pursuant to an option or otherwise) by the Directors pursuant to the mandate in paragraph (a) above, otherwise than pursuant to:
 - (i) a Rights Issue (as defined below);
 - (ii) the exercise of options granted under the share option scheme of the Company;
 - (iii) any scrip dividend scheme or similar arrangement providing for the allotment and issue of Shares in lieu of the whole or part of a dividend on Shares in accordance with the bye-laws of the Company (“**Bye-laws**”); and
 - (iv) any issue of Shares upon the exercise of rights of subscription or conversion under the terms of any warrants, convertible bonds, debentures, notes or any securities issued by the Company which are convertible into Shares,

shall not exceed the aggregate of:

- (aa) 20% of the aggregate number of issued Shares on the date of passing of this resolution; and
- (bb) (if the Directors are so authorised by a separate ordinary resolution of the shareholders of the Company (“**Shareholders**”)) the aggregate number of issued Shares which may be repurchased by the Company subsequent to the passing of this resolution (up to a maximum equivalent to 10% of the number of issued Shares on the date of the passing of this resolution);

and the authority pursuant to paragraph (a) of this resolution shall be limited accordingly;

- (d) if, after the passing of this resolution, the Company conducts a share consolidation or subdivision, the numbers of Shares subject to the limit set out in paragraph (c) above shall be adjusted to the effect that the number of Shares subject to the limit set out in paragraph (c) above as a percentage of the total number of issued Shares at the date immediately before and after such consolidation or subdivision shall be the same, and
- (e) for the purposes of this resolution:

“**Relevant Period**” means the period from the passing of this resolution until whichever is the earliest of:

- (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company;
- (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by any applicable laws or by the Bye-laws to be held after the Meeting; or
- (iii) the passing of an ordinary resolution by the Shareholders in a general meeting to be held after the Meeting revoking or varying the mandate granted under this resolution.

“**Rights Issue**” means an offer of Shares, or an offer of warrants, options or other securities giving rights to subscribe for Shares, open for a period fixed by the Directors to holders of Shares or any class of Shares whose names appear on the Company’s register of members on a fixed record date in proportion to their then holdings of Shares (subject to such exclusion or other arrangements as the Directors may deem necessary or expedient in relation to fractional entitlements, or having regard to any restrictions or obligations under the laws of, or the requirements of, or the expenses or delay which may be involved in determining the existence or extent of any restrictions or obligations under the laws of, or the requirements of, jurisdiction outside Hong Kong or any recognised regulatory body or any stock exchange outside Hong Kong).”

10. “**THAT:**

- (a) subject to paragraph (b) below, the exercise by the Directors during the Relevant Period (as defined below) of all the powers of the Company to repurchase Shares on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (“**Stock Exchange**”) in accordance with all applicable laws, rules and regulations, be and is hereby generally and unconditionally approved;

- (b) the total number of Shares to be purchased pursuant to the mandate in paragraph (a) above shall not exceed 10% of the aggregate number of issued Shares as at the date of passing of this resolution and the said mandate shall be limited accordingly;
- (c) if, after the passing of this resolution, the Company conducts a share consolidation or subdivision, the number of Shares subject to the limit set out in paragraph (b) above shall be adjusted to the effect that the number of Shares subject to the limit set out in paragraph (b) above as a percentage of the total number of issued Shares at the date immediately before and after such consolidation or subdivision shall be the same; and
- (d) for the purpose of this resolution:

“**Relevant Period**” means the period from the passing of this resolution until whichever is the earliest of:

- (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company to be held after the Meeting;
- (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by any applicable laws or by the Bye-laws to be held after the Meeting; or
- (iii) the passing of an ordinary resolution by the Shareholders in a general meeting to be held after the Meeting revoking or varying the mandate granted under this resolution.”

11. “**THAT** conditional upon the passing of resolutions set out in items 9 and 10 of the notice convening the Meeting (“**Notice**”), the general mandate referred to in the resolution set out in item 9 of the Notice be and is hereby extended by the addition to the number of Shares which may be allotted and issued or dealt with or agreed conditionally or unconditionally to be allotted, issued or dealt with by the Directors pursuant to or in accordance with such general mandate of an amount representing the aggregate number of Shares repurchased by the Company pursuant to the general mandate referred to in the resolution set out in item 10 of the Notice, provided that such extended amount shall not exceed 10% of the aggregate number of issued Shares on the date of passing of this resolution.”

12. “**THAT** subject to and conditional upon the Listing Committee of the Stock Exchange granting the listing of, and permission to deal in, such number of Shares which may fall to be allotted and issued pursuant to the exercise of the options which may be granted under the Share Option Scheme, representing 10% of the number of issued Shares as at the date on which this resolution is passed, pursuant to the rules of the Share Option Scheme (terms as defined in the circular to the Shareholders dated 20 November 2017 having the same meanings when used in this resolution):
- (a) approval be and is hereby granted for refreshing the 10% mandate under the Share Option Scheme (“**Refreshed Scheme Mandate**”) provided that the total number of Shares which may be allotted and issued upon the exercise of all options to be granted under the Share Option Scheme and any other share option schemes of the Company under the limit as refreshed hereby shall not exceed 10% of the aggregate number of issued Shares as at the date on which this resolution is passed (options previously granted under the Share Option Scheme and any other share option schemes of the Company (including options outstanding, cancelled, lapsed or exercised in accordance with the terms of the Share Option Scheme or any other share option schemes of the Company) shall not be counted for the purpose of calculating the Refreshed Scheme Mandate); and
 - (b) the Directors or a duly authorised committee thereof be and is/are hereby authorised: (i) at its/their absolute discretion, to grant options to subscribe for Shares within the Refreshed Scheme Mandate in accordance with the rules of the Share Option Scheme, and (ii) to allot, issue and deal with Shares pursuant to the exercise of options granted under the Share Option Scheme within the Refreshed Scheme Mandate, and

if, after the passing of this resolution, the Company conducts a share consolidation or subdivision, the number of Shares that may be issued upon exercise of all options to be granted under the Share Option Scheme and any other share option schemes of the Company or its subsidiaries under the Refreshed Scheme Mandate shall be adjusted to the effect that the number of Shares that may be issued upon exercise of all options to be granted under the Share Option Scheme and any other share option schemes of the Company or its subsidiaries under the Refreshed Scheme Mandate as a percentage of the total number of issued Shares at the date immediately before and after such consolidation or subdivision shall be the same.”

- (1) Any Shareholder entitled to attend and vote at the Meeting is entitled to appoint a proxy to attend and vote on behalf of him/her. A proxy needs not be a Shareholder. A Shareholder who is the holder of two or more Shares may appoint more than one proxy to represent him/her to attend and vote on his/her behalf. If more than one proxy is so appointed, the appointment shall specify the number and class of Shares in respect of which each such proxy is so appointed.
- (2) In order to be valid, the form of proxy together with the power of attorney or other authority, if any, under which it is signed or a notarially certified copy of that power of attorney or authority, must be deposited at the Company's branch share registrar and transfer office in Hong Kong, Tricor Investor Services Limited, at Level 22, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Hong Kong, as soon as possible but in any event by 10:15 a.m. (Hong Kong time) on Sunday, 17 December 2017 or not less than 48 hours before any adjournment of the Meeting. Delivery of the form of proxy shall not preclude a Shareholder from attending and voting in person at the Meeting and, in such event, the form of proxy shall be deemed to be revoked.
- (3) In order to determine the right to attend the Meeting, the register of members of the Company will be closed from Wednesday, 13 December 2017 to Tuesday, 19 December 2017 (both days inclusive), during which no transfer of Shares can be registered. To qualify for the attendance at the Meeting, Shareholders must ensure that all transfer documents accompanied by the relevant share certificates must be lodged with the Company's branch share registrar and transfer office in Hong Kong, Tricor Investor Services Limited, at Level 22, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Hong Kong not later than 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, 12 December 2017.
- (4) Where there are joint registered holders of any Shares, any one of such persons may vote at the Meeting, either personally or by proxy, in respect of such Shares as if he/she were solely entitled thereto; but if more than one of such joint holders are present at the Meeting personally or by proxy, that one of the said persons so present being the most, or, as the case may be, the more senior shall alone be entitled to vote in respect of the relevant joint holding and, for this purpose, seniority shall be determined by reference to the order in which the names of the joint holders stand in the register of members in respect of the relevant joint holding.
- (5) As required under the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on the Stock Exchange, the above resolutions shall be decided by way of poll.
